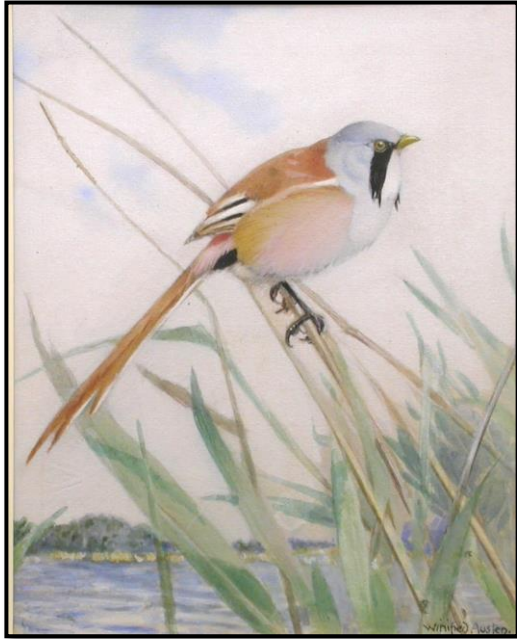

If you have a piece that you would like to include, please contact us. We will be pleased to receive appropriate pictures and sculptures up to Sunday 18th February.

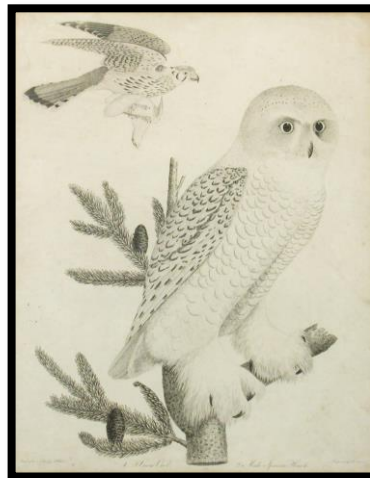

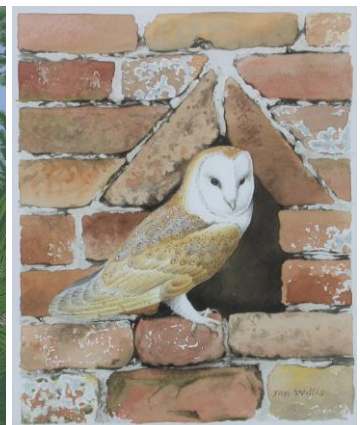
Other highlights include:
